US YOUTH SOCCER SOUTH REGION ANDY STONE SCHOLARSHIP OVERVIEW

The Andy Stone Scholarship was set up by the South Region to honor the dedication and commitment of Andy Stone, former South Region Chair. Any active high school senior member of the South Region may apply for the scholarship as per the guidelines listed below.

Andy Stone Scholarship

1. **PERPETUAL:** Funds will be invested and open for continued contributions.

2. ELIGIBILITY:

- a. No member of a State or Regional staff is eligible.
- b. Is available for all registered youth players, coaches and/or referees. Will be judged on:
 - Years and depth of involvement
 - Academics
 - Needs
 - Citizenship
 - Extracurricular activities

3. AMOUNT:

Four \$1,500 Scholarships, (one boy and one girl from 2 states), will be granted. Tyrone Gonzalez (Events and Operations Manager, US Youth Soccer) and the State Associations will coordinate where the scholarship checks will be sent, either to the recipient directly or the State Association for presentation by such association. The State Association will determine the time/place presentation of the award (if applicable).

- **4. SELECTION:** The State Associations will determine the winner of the scholarships based on the attached application form. The name of the winners and a copy of his/her application must be received by Tyrone Gonzalez (Events and Operations Manager, US Youth Soccer) no later than May 1st of each year.
- 5. **SCHOLARSHIP ROTATION:** The scholarship will be offered to the states of the South Region, two states at a time, beginning in 2017 with South Texas and Alabama. The first award was in 1999 to Mississippi, Andy's home state. The succession shall rotate alphabetically as follows:
