Oct. 2025 Coaches Education Report.

Coach Cottle has been working with the Dallas Independent School District with the aim of expanding NTSSA coach education and getting all of their junior high and high school coaches education up to the D level. This month he is running a 7v7 and a 9v9 course with the enrollment sitting at 14 in each course.

Coach Cottle is also working with the Dallas Surf Soccer Club in putting on 9v9 and 11V11 courses as well. Currently both courses are sitting at 12. Coach Cottle has been in dialogue with many of the local clubs to have their newer and younger coaches invest in their people so they can do a better job in coaching the younger players in their clubs, and how NTSAA can help them, and work around US Club Soccer.

The NTSAA sponsored USSF National Spring B Course is filling up with 12 candidates currently. We have also been given permission to host a fall 26 National USSF B Course from Scott Flood who assigns these courses for USSF.

The coach education department is getting requests for spring 2026 D and C Courses.

Coach Cottle and I are working together on putting on a 2026 Coaching Symposium in February. We have spoken to three guests who all have shown interest in participating as the head liner. We both agree that because of the World Cup and the NTSSA summer AGM we feel it would not be smart to have in the summer. I have also spoken to coach Cottle in exploring the idea of having a Coaching Symposium for his Educational Staff and his ODP Staff.

- First Coach for the Community is a program sponsored by US Soccer to expose first-time youth coaches to coach education. It was hosted by the Wylie Soccer Association. This is a free clinic that provides each attendee with a voucher for an online grassroots course for free. 12 Coaches attended. Warren was the instructor.
- NTSSA Coach Education Department again has been selected to host a B Coaching Course this spring for the second spring in a row. Registration for the spring B will open this Weekend. US Soccer has asked to use the B&C Coaching Courses held in North Texas this fall to provide feedback to help them develop and improve the learning coaching center experience.
- The current plan is to offer more grassroots and statewide D courses and apply with US Soccer to host two National C courses for the year 2026.
- With the success of the summer coaching symposium, we are looking to make this an annual event to host high-profile coaches for our A/B license coaches, college coaches and high school coaches, and recreational coaches to receive further education. Because of the World Cup this summer, we are looking to host this event in late February. Warren has secured Boswell High School for the weekend of February 27th at no cost.
- Warren would like to host a one-day vertical alignment instructors meeting to go through all of the courses so as to provide a clearer path from one course to another.
