ANNOUNCEMENTS AND UPDATES

Janet Campbell reviewed the following with the Board:

- The business that was undertaken at the USYS AGM in July. The bylaw proposal she submitted to allow any state representative (not just Board members) to run for Youth Council Commissioners passed. The bylaw proposal she submitted to clarify the process for USYS to register players directly got a majority of the vote, but not the 2/3rds needed to pass. Several other bylaw proposals also got a majority, but not 2/3rds, and therefore did not pass. The USYS Board assured the membership that they got the message and would communicate more closely with the states. The At Large Board Representative that we supported won their election.
- The USASA AGM will be in Florida in September. Rach, Jerry, David Messersmith, and Janet are scheduled to attend.
- The USSF AGM for 2024 will be in Dallas, which will allow for more North Texas attendees to observe.
- The USYSA Workshops in January will be in Anaheim, California. Janet asked those who are interested in going to let her know so we can determine who will be going to stay within our approved budget.
- Janet asked those present what would be a good date for the Board and Staff Christmas Party this year. The group requested December 8 or 9.



How would you rate the overall quality of your experience at the international Coaching Symposium?





The North Texas Soccer Referee Program had one of its most successful summers to date. Two referees were selected from Regional Presidents Cup to attend National Presidents Cup in Kansas, three referees were selected from Youth Regionals to attend Youth Nationals in Florida, and one referee was selected to attend Amateur Nationals from Amateur Regionals held here in Plano.

July saw very productive sessions held at the AGM with positive feedback from assignors and those who attended the referee sessions. Nine young referees worked with the groups to explain how they could improve retention in their associations by providing details about why they continue to recertify.

WhistleMania was held July 15 at Benbrook Soccer Complex with great help from Rob Martella, Javier Perdomo, and dozens of other volunteers and mentors, coaches, and assignors. Almost 400 people attended the inaugural event with 111 new referees being certified and hundreds of others receiving practical instruction in rotating field sessions led by coaches, mentors, and Regional and National Referees. The event allowed referees to meet with assignors afterwards in a job-fair format then enjoy some fun soccer-themed games. Returning referees were also given a discount on their 2024 registration if completed by July 31. We are looking forward to WhistleMania II next July.

Entry-level clinics began July 29 with one being held in Cleburne and another in Dallas at Richland College—welcoming 41 new referees. More than 20 more clinics are already scheduled for this fall.

Recertification for referees, assignors, and coaches begins August 1, 2023. We are looking to improve upon the recovery we had in 2023 and get back closer to normal registration numbers.
