

February was a fairly quiet month.

Thank you to the board for reviewing and approving provisional membership during the February board meeting.

I look forward to being back on the pitch this spring.



The North Texas Soccer Referee Program currently has 4369 registered referees and continues to grow each day. Our goal for this registration year is to surpass 5,200 registered referees in order to continue showing growth each year since the pandemic decline that started in 2020—plummeting to 3,919 in 2021. 2024 registration numbers (5,123) surpassed 2020 numbers (5,038) but did not reach the previous 2019 high of 5,673. Recertification badges are being distributed by OfficialSports this year, and the move has been somewhat frustrating in its first year.

We are in the planning stages of WhistleMania® 3, which will be held at Railroad Park July 12-13, 2025. This year we have expanded WhistleMania® to two-days and will train new referees the first day and returning referees the second day. WM1 registered 110 new referees come into the program, and WM2 registered 177. This year's goal for WM3 is to register 300 new referees. New referees attending the event provide the program the greatest opportunity for growth. We are planning for 300 returning referees to attend the event July 13.

Our development groups continue to provide solid training to the Junior Elite, Elite, and FORCE groups. The Elite and Junior Elite February sessions covered some of the training that was provided at this year's National Camp. Jam sessions continue to be popular monthly trainings for officials with a Referee license. We had over 75 people join the Zoom training in February.

The referee committee is planning multiple Zoom sessions for referees, coaches, association members, and assignors around the new US Soccer Referee Abuse Policy (RAP) and the new green badges for minor referees. The goal is to provide a soccer community that works in harmony supporting the players we all serve.

Bret Harp and I traveled to Atlanta for the final two days of the US Soccer AGM and the US Soccer Referee Workshop. There is great excitement in the referee world with the hirings of Kari Seitz and Brian Hall. These two, with their teams, have begun a huge transformation of the US Soccer Referee Program.

The North Texas Soccer Referee Program will host the OMS Workshop once again this year. All state referee committees who use the registration platform have been invited to state office in Frisco March 22-23. Thanks to the honorable former national award-winning Rob Martella for helping organize this workshop.
