### ***State Association Coordination:***

As you prepare for Nationals, teams must work directly with their State Association to complete the following:

- Roster submission and player eligibility
- Team payments and entry requirements
- State-specific procedures and deadlines
- Any additional administrative requirements

Your State Association is your primary point of contact for these items and will guide you through the process.

***Event Format:***

- Days 1–3: Group play
- Day 4: Final
- Top two teams from each group of four advance to the final

***Hotel Information:***

Hotel inventory for the US Youth Soccer National Presidents Cup Qualifiers is being managed in partnership with On Location | Anthony Travel and released in strategic, incremental waves to ensure all advancing teams have an equal opportunity to secure accommodations.

Inventory will be available for all qualified teams regardless of whether they qualify early in the process or closer to the event date.

Once a team qualifies for their respective Presidents Cup Qualifier event, they will be able to book live hotel inventory beginning March 4, 2026, at 10:00 AM CST.
